Instructions to speakers

AGCI sessions are designed to maximize discussion. Therefore, speakers are instructed to allow time for discussion as part of their time slot allotted in the agenda as follows:

Overview talks Monday (45 minutes on agenda; 30 minute talk and 15 minutes for discussion)

Decadal prediction topics Tuesday (30 minutes on agenda; 20 minute talk and 10 minutes for discussion)
